Notice of Race

1 RULES

1.1 The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 issued by the ISAF, including the Appendix except where amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 This is a closed event for competitors who are **current students** of tertiary institutions in Singapore.
- 2.2 All competitors **shall** possess the Level 1 Windsurfing Proficiency certification or its equivalent.
- 2.3 Each university may send a maximum of <u>2</u> competitors for each **Novice 4.0m** category (Men and Women), a maximum of <u>2</u> competitors for <u>5.5m</u> **Intermediate Men**, a maximum of <u>2</u> competitors for <u>4.7m</u> **Intermediate Women** category and a maximum of <u>2</u> competitors for <u>6.2m</u> **Intermediate Mixed**.
- 2.4 For competitors of the **Novice 4.0m** categories, they <u>must</u> be in their first year of racing in external competitions (specifically, the SIM Windsurfing Championships). Additionally, they should not have competed in more than 3 external races.
- 2.5 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the attached entry form and sending it (complete with physical signatures) to windsurfing@mymail.sim.edu.sg

3 FEES

3.1 The entry fee (inclusive of GST) for all categories will be \$50.00 per tertiary competitor.

Fees are **non-refundable**. Receipts will be issued on the first day of the race, in exchange of the Bank transaction receipt.

- 6.2 Competitors have to do an equipment check and sail to National Sailing Centre from Constant Wind Sea Sports Centre on the 17th &/or 18th January, 1300hrs 1800hrs. Do notify Sean or Leonard (Mobile Numbers at the end), before heading down.
- 6.3 Allocation of equipment shall be on a first-come-first-served basis and any request for a change will be subject to approval.

10 SAILING COURSE

10.1 The course will be described in the Sailing Instructions. There is no minimum wind strength.

11 SCORING

11.1 The ISAF Appendix "A" Low Point Scoring System will apply. Where 4 or more races are conducted, 1 discard will be allowed.

12 REGISTRATION DEADLINE

- 12.1 All entries, accompanied by the entry fees, must be submitted to SIM Windsurfing Club on the official entry form by **9**th **January 2015.**
- 12.2 Incomplete entries and/or entries without its entry fees will **NOT** be accepted after the closing date.

13 PRIZES

13.1 1st to 3rd prizes will be awarded to the top 3 competitors in each category.

14 RACING GUIDE

- 14.1 All competitors are required to sign in and sign out before launching and after returning to shore. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification.
- 14.2 All competitors are advised to have a light breakfast before arriving for the event on both days.
- 14.2 Lunch will be provided on the first day.
- 14.3 Lunch and dinner will be provided on the second day.

15 SAFETY

- 15.1 All competitors must wear a personal flotation device at all times when out at sea.
- 15.2 Failure to comply with the safety regulations will lead to automatic disqualification.
