1 RULES

- 1.1 This event will run as per this NOR and Sailing Instruction. And whatever the OD says.
- 1.2 In the event of a discrepancy, the organizing committee will make the decision and will have the final say no further appeals thereafter.

2 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

2.1 The participating **Classes** and **Divisions** shall be:

Class: RS: One, Bic Techno and Race-board with maximum sail size of ≤7.8 sq m

- a) Masters (> 55 years as of 19 December 2020)
- b) Students
- c) Local University Alumni

Class: Race-board with maximum sail size of 6 sq m

Formula Class - Open

Foiling Class - Open

- 2.2 A minimum of 3 participants is required to form a class.
 - a) Within a class, a minimum of 3 participants is required to form a division
 - b) If there are insufficient participants to form a division, all participants will compete under a combined division within the class.
 - c) The organizing committee reserves the overall right to decide the final formation of divisions and classes for this event.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Participants shall be existing members of Windsurfing Association Singapore (WAS).

Application for WAS Membership may be completed on site during the race day itself or apply online via WAS website.

4 FEES

Ordinary Rate:

S\$ 30 - This includes rental of RS1/ Bic Techno board and sail

S\$ 10 – If participant uses own equipment


Student rate:

S\$ 15 - This includes rental of RS1/ Bic Techno / Race board and sail


S\$ 10 - If participant uses own equipment

5.1 This shall consist of 2 races.

1st **Leg for Windsurfers**: Start (OD will advise the start line), Windward mark, Keta buoy to starboard, Bedok buoy to starboard, Siglap buoy to starboard, Finish (Between boat and blue mark in front of Aloha).



2nd **Leg for Windsurfers**: Start (Between boat and blue mark in front of Aloha), Bedok to port, Keta to port, NEA buoy to port, Finish (Between Blue mark in front of Constantwind and boat with blue flag).



Race Route for Foil:

Leg 1 will be CW to Bedok, then Keta, then Bedok and then to Aloha (all Starboard rounding)

Leg 2 will be Aloha to Keta, then Bedok, then Keta and then to Constant Wind (all Port rounding)
