NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

 Windsurfing Competition Rules and The Class Rules of the participating classes.
- 1.2 National prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is conflict between the Notice of Raceand the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI's will take precedence.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' applies.

3 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

- 3.1 The participating **classes** and divisions shall be:
- 3.1.1 **RS:One** Men, Espoir Men, Women, Espoir Women, Master and Grand Master
- 3.1.2 **Techno 293** Youth Boy and Girl; Junior Boy and Girl
- 3.1.3 **Techno 293 Plus** Youth Boy and Girl; Open Men and Women
- 3.1.4 Formula Windsurfing Open & Masters
- 3.1.5 Raceboard (with 6 / 5.5 / 4m sail) Men, Women, Master, Grand Master
- 3.1.6 **Wind Foil** Men, Women, Youth Boys & Girls, Masters, Grand Masters
- 3.2 **Age Divisions**:
- 3.2.1 A Techno Junior shall be under 15 years of age and born 2007 or later
- 3.2.2 A Techno Youth shall be under 17 years of age and born 2005 or later
- 3.2.3 A Techno 293 Plus Youth shall be under 17 years of age, born 2005 or later
- 3.2.4 An RS:One Espoir shall be under 22 years of age, born 2000 or later.
- 3.2.5 A Master shall be a man 40 years of age, or older in the year of competition (born 1981 or earlier).
- 3.2.6 A Grand Master shall be a man of 50 years of age or older, in the year of competition (born 1971 or earlier)
- 3.2.7 A minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a class.
 - a) Within a class, a minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a division
 - b) If there are insufficient competitors to form a division, all competitors will compete under a combined division within the class.
 - c) The organizing committee reserves the overall right to decide the final formation of divisions and classes for this event.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-EligibilityCode.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a current paid up member of the relevant international class association. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the attached form by **21**st **February 2020 see item 19**

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- o Original Entry Form
- Proof ofage
- o Parental Permission Form- for competitors under the age of 18

5 FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fee for competitors is:
 - S\$ 100 for all classes except Race board (6 / 5.5 / 4 m sail) for students.
 - S\$ 50 for students racing on Race board (6 / 5.5 / 4 m sail)
- 5.1.1 For registration done **before 6pm, 21th February 2021**, the entry fees are as follows:
 - S\$ 80 for all classes except Race board (6 / 5.5 / 4 m sail) for students.
 - S\$ 40 for students racing on Race board (6 / 5.5 / 4 m sail)
- 5.2 Entry fees may be paid in cash at registration or via bank transfer (see details below) with all bank charges to be borne by the participant.

6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 Each event in the Open Championship shall be a single discipline, *course racing*, "Open entry" event.
- 6.2 Men and women, boys and girls, may race together.
- 6.3 Classes may have separate starts.
- 6.4 All Classes, except Windfoil shall race a maximum 4 races per day, in a maximum 8 race series. Foiling shall race a maximum of 9 races per day, in a maximum of 18 race series.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Organizing Committee.

9 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

10 PROTEST COMMITTEE

An 'Independent Protest Committee' will be appointed.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except as amended below for discards.
- 11.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4 When 8 to 14 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her racescores excluding her two worst scores.
- 11.5 When 15 or more races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her racescores excluding her three worst scores.
- 11.6 Marathon race does not form part of the series.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office.

13 SAFETY

Every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.

All are to comply to the COVID safe practice rules – see Safe Return to Sport Plan from SSF.

14 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
- 15.2 Apart from the Open Division, winners of each division shall only be entitled to prizes within their respective division.
- 15.3 Prizes shall also be awarded to Marathon race winners

15 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 Decision to Race. The organising authorities (WAS, Aloha, Constant Wind, SingaporeSailing) or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

17 INSURANCE

Each participant is advised on their own, to take up an insurance to cover any mishaps.

18 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
